9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 151, L.D. 174, Bill, "An Act To
10 Amend the Law Governing Employment, Discipline and Dismissal of Chief Deputy
11 Sheriffs"

12 Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the
13 following:

14 'Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §383, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

15 5. Minimum qualifications. The chief deputy must meet the minimum
16 qualifications for sheriffs pursuant to section 371-B, subsection 3.'

17 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
18 section number to read consecutively.

19 SUMMARY

20 This amendment adds a requirement that the chief deputy sheriff hold the same
21 qualifications as a sheriff.
