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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 179, L.D. 202, Bill, "An Act To
Modify Child Support Enforcement Procedures"

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Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 3 (page 1, lines 4 and 5 in
L.D.) and inserting the following:

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'3. **Duration.** The order continues in effect for ~~6 months~~ one year or until the obligor
finds work, whichever occurs first.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment reinstates the limitation, which was removed in the bill, on a court
order for a child support obligor, expanding the limitation from 6 months as in current
law to one year.
