2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§92 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	92. Performing arts organizations. Sales to incorporated nonprofit performing arts organizations organized for the purpose of providing arts, educational or cultural programs to a live audience, including, but not limited to, music, dance and theater.
