Fiscal Detail and Notes

This floor amendment removes the emergency preamble. The incremental effect compared to the committee amendment is the elimination of the fiscal year 2010-11 General Fund appropriation and restoration of the fiscal year 2010-11 Other Special Revenue Funds allocation and revenue that was reduced by the committee amendment.
