SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 60,
L.D. 210, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Saltwater Recreational Fishing Registry"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in §6312 in subsection 3 by striking out all of
paragraph G (page 2, line 12 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'G. A resident fishing on July 4th, Labor Day weekend or Memorial Day weekend;'

SUMMARY

This amendment restores the exemption in current law that allows a resident to fish
on July 4th, Memorial Day weekend or Labor Day weekend without registering on the
saltwater recreational fishing registry.
