COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “**A**” to S.P. 65, L.D. 214, Bill, “An Act To Establish Governor William King Day”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §150-F in the indented paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "February 9th" and inserting the following: 'March 16th'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment establishes Governor William King Day on March 16th, to fall the day after Statehood Day. The bill established February 9th as Governor William King Day.
