1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §150-F** is enacted to read:

3 **§150-F. Governor William King Day**

4 The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation indicating February 9th of each
5 year as Governor William King Day in honor of the first Governor of Maine, a proponent
6 of statehood for Maine.
