The department shall identify best practice measures for reducing the smoking 21 rate of MaineCare members. The department shall determine ways to increase use of the 22 MaineCare tobacco treatment benefit while working within existing resources to fund 23 projects necessary to reach MaineCare members. The department shall submit a written 24 report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health 25 and human services matters on its progress under this section by November 30th each 26 year through 2014.'
