COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 71, L.D. 220, Bill, "An Act Relating to
Maine Farm Wineries"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the
summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355, sub-§3, ¶E is enacted to read:

E. A holder of a farm winery license may display up to 25 bottles in the windows of
any premises maintained and licensed as permitted premises under paragraph C
where wine produced by the holder of the farm winery license is sold.'

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the provision of the bill that allows farm wineries to sell
wine at farmers' markets and the provision that allows for the development of a uniform
system of signage for farm wineries. It also clarifies in which premises a farm winery
may display wine in windows.
