4 5 6 7	A high school diploma may be awarded only to a secondary school student who has registered to vote in accordance with Title 21-A, section 122, unless that student is not eligible to register pursuant to Title 21-A. School guidance counselors shall certify that a student has registered to vote in accordance with this section.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11 12	This bill requires all high school students that are eligible under the laws governing elections to register to vote in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 122 prior to graduation. School guidance counselors are responsible for certifying that students have registered to vote.
