L.D. 277, Bill, "An Act To Make Disputed Ballots in State Elections Public"

Amend the amendment in the 2nd paragraph after the title in the 6th line (page 1, line
18 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "public" the following: 'after the
outcome of the election is finally determined'

public inspection copies of unresolved disputed ballots after the outcome of the election
is finally determined.
