COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 230, L.D. 286, Bill, "An Act To Allow Oak Grove Cemetery To Operate a Crematorium on a Parcel of Land Less than 20 Acres"

Amend the bill in section 2 in the last line (page 1, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or the City of Gardiner"

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that the site on which a crematorium is to be constructed be owned by Oak Grove Cemetery rather than owned by Oak Grove Cemetery or the City of Gardiner, as proposed in the bill.
