COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 244, L.D. 302, Bill, "An Act To Allow an Angler To Gift a Freshwater Fish to a Person Who Is Not Licensed To Fish"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §12613 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "unless the gift fish" and inserting the following: 'except a person may possess in that person's domicile a gift fish that'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §12613 in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "year" the following: ', month and day'

SUMMARY

This amendment limits the possession of a gift fish to a person's domicile.
