1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **CONCEPT DRAFT** 3 **SUMMARY** 4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. 5 This bill proposes to establish a public-private partnership at the state level with responsibility for the development and delivery of a comprehensive, coordinated and 6 coherent strategy for economic development in Maine. This private-public partnership 7 8 shall work with regional and local economic development councils and businesses to 9 provide an array of services to companies seeking to locate or expand in Maine. 10 This bill proposes the development of a "Maine brand" to consistently promote the quality of life in Maine, the quality of Maine recreation and vacation experiences and the 11 quality of Maine-made products. 12 13 This bill proposes to examine existing economic development programs and appropriations and allocations to each and to redirect funds to support a coherent strategy 14

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and maximize positive outcomes.
