# CONCEPT DRAFT

## SUMMARY

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This bill proposes to authorize Cumberland County, which recently adopted a comprehensive home rule charter by referendum, to provide regional educational services, including back-office services for school districts within the county, and specialized educational services such as regional vocational education, special education, a regional science and technology high school or other regional educational initiatives.
