2 3	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2083, sub-§1, ¶ C, as amended by PL 2005, c. 577, §33, is further amended to read:
4 5	C. An operator of a motorcycle, operating under a learner's permit or within one year 10 years of successfully completing a driving test; and
6	SUMMARY
7 8	This bill requires an operator of a motorcycle who has held a license endorsed for the operation of a motorcycle for less than 10 years to wear protective headgear.
