4 5 6 7	D. The vessel on regularly scheduled ferry operations between Bar Harbor, Maine and Yarmouth, Nova Scotia, provided that the master of such vessel has completed an appropriate number of trips, as established by commission rules and has met any appropriate federal requirements—:

10 11 12	E. All military ships navigating the Kennebec River to and from the Bath Iron Works Corporation for the purpose of accomplishing overhaul, repair, post shakedown availability and sea trials-; and
13	Sec. 3. 38 MRSA §87-A, sub-§1, ¶F is enacted to read:
14	F. Noncommercial foreign vessels with overall length of under 200 feet.

16 17	This bill exempts noncommercial foreign vessels of under 200 feet from the requirement that a pilot licensed in this State be on board.
