COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 126, L.D. 422, Bill, "An Act To mend the Laws Governing the Tax Assessment for Correctional Services in Lincoln ounty and Sagadahoc County"
Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and aserting the following:
'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not ecome effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
Whereas, in order for Lincoln County to change its tax assessment for correctional ervices effective July 1, 2011 and for Lincoln County to pay withheld money to Two ridges Regional Jail by July 1, 2011, this legislation must take effect before the end of a 90-day period; and
Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within ne meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as numediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, herefore,
e it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §701, sub-§2-A, ¶H, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 653, Pt. A, 8, is amended to read:
H. A sum of \$3,018,361 <u>\$2,657,105</u> in Lincoln County;
Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §701, sub-§2-A, ¶L, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 653, Pt. A, 8, is amended to read:
L. A sum of \$2,295,849 <u>\$2,657,105</u> in Sagadahoc County;
Sec. 3. Lincoln County payment to Two Bridges Regional Jail. Lincoln ounty shall pay all withheld revenue from its tax assessment for correctional services om July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2011 directly to the Two Bridges Regional Jail by July 1, 011 for the jail's correctional services operations in fiscal year 2012-13.

ROFS COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 126, L.D. 422

 Sec. 4. Effective date. That section of this Act that amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 701, subsection 2-A, paragraph H takes effect July 1, 2011. That section of this Act that amends Title 30-A, section 701, subsection 2-A, paragraph L takes effect January 1, 2012.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved, except as otherwise indicated.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and resets and makes equal the tax assessment for correctional services for Lincoln County and Sagadahoc County. These changes take effect for Lincoln County on July 1, 2011 and for Sagadahoc County on January 1, 2012. The amendment also directs Lincoln County to pay withheld revenue from its tax assessment for correctional services from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2011 directly to the Two Bridges Regional Jail by July 1, 2011 for the jail's correctional services operations in fiscal year 2012-13. The amendment also adds an emergency preamble and clause.
