The Secretary of State shall publish on a publicly accessible website all executive orders in effect on the effective date of this subsection and, for an effective executive order issued after the effective date of this subsection, within 24 hours of the order's issuance.

8 9 10	This bill requires the Secretary of State to publish on a publicly accessible website all executive orders in effect and, for an executive order issued after this bill takes effect, within 24 hours of the order's issuance.
