COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 361, L.D. 468, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Bear Hunting"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 to 5 (page 1, lines 6 to 21 in L.D.)

Amend the bill in section 8 in paragraph C in the 2nd line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "8th" and inserting the following: '4th'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes language from the bill regarding the hunting season on bears using dogs and establishing bait sites on another person's land without written permission. The written permission to place bait was addressed in another bill. It also changes the day before the open bear season a person can train dogs on bear from the 8th day to the 4th day.
