11 12	Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of paragraph D (page 1, lines 29 and 30 in amendment) and inserting the following:
13 14 15	'D. More than 4 hours in any day when the minor's school is in session, except that the minor may work up to 8 hours on a day that an authorized school closure occurs in that minor's school and the last scheduled day of the school week;'
16 17	Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
18	SUMMARY
19 20 21 22	This amendment strikes the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" that extend the hours of work permitted per day from 4 hours to 6 hours, and specifies that a minor may work up to 8 hours on each day that an authorized school closure occurs in that minor's school.  SPONSORED BY:
