1 **Sec. 1. Bureau of Insurance to study the health insurance benefits of**
2 **Legislators. Resolved:** That the Department of Professional and Financial
3 Regulation, Bureau of Insurance shall study the health insurance benefits provided to
4 Legislators with respect to the premium paid by employer and employee, the cost by
5 family composition, cost-sharing and type and level of benefits and prepare a side-by-side
6 comparison of insurance provided to other part-time and seasonal workers in the State
7 with respect to each of the categories. The bureau shall submit a report of the results of
8 the study to the Joint Standing Committee on Insurance and Financial Services by
9 December 1, 2011.

SUMMARY

11 This bill directs the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of
12 Insurance to study the health insurance premium, cost, cost-sharing and benefits provided
13 to Legislators and compare them to the premium, cost, cost-sharing and benefits available
14 to other part-time and seasonal workers in the State, and to provide a report to the Joint
15 Standing Committee on Insurance and Financial Services by December 1, 2011.
