COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 405, L.D. 522, Bill, "An Act To Provide Free Hunting, Fishing and Trapping Licenses To Wartime Veterans Who Are at Least 80 Years of Age"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Provide Free Hunting, Fishing and Trapping Licenses to Nonresident Wartime Veterans Who Are at Least 80 Years of Age'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-B in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "older" the following: 'nonresident'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-B in the 5th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "resident" and inserting the following: 'nonresident'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-B in paragraph A in the first line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "resident" and inserting the following: 'nonresident'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-B in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "resident's" and inserting the following: 'nonresident's'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-B in paragraph A in the 4th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "resident" and inserting the following: 'nonresident'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. It provides that the complimentary licenses may be issued only to nonresidents, instead of residents as proposed in the bill.
