#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Removing the approval and oversight requirements for local only "alternative delivery" school construction projects will eliminate the potential General Fund costs to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services and the Department of Education.

Since this legislation, as amended, affects locally approved school construction projects that are paid for using local funding, there is no fiscal impact to the State.
