8 9 10	C. Assume responsibility or incur liability for any injury to person or property caused by any act of persons to whom the permission is granted even if that injury occurs on property of another person-; or
11	Sec. 3. 14 MRSA §159-A, sub-§3, ¶D is enacted to read:
12 13 14 15	D. Assume responsibility or liability for any penalties for violations of laws administered by the Department of Environmental Protection or the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission caused by acts of others involved in recreational or harvesting activities.
