1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §98, sub-§2**, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 563, §3, is amended to
3 read:

4 **2. Chair; meetings; secretary.** The Pull Events Commission shall elect one of its
5 members as chair. The chair serves a 2-year term and may not serve as chair for
6 consecutive terms. The commission shall meet a minimum of twice annually. The
7 ~~agricultural fair coordinator from~~ commissioner shall designate an employee of the
8 department ~~shall~~ to serve as secretary to the Pull Events Commission.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 Current law designates the agricultural fair coordinator from the Department of
11 Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to serve as secretary of the Pull Events
12 Commission. This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural
13 Resources to designate an employee of the department to serve as secretary of the Pull
14 Events Commission.
