16	SUMMARY
17	This amendment, which is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on
18	Transportation, clarifies that holders of commercial driver's licenses are exempt from the
19	prohibition against using a handheld cellular telephone and a handheld electronic device
20 21	while operating a commercial motor vehicle. This amendment also provides that the
21 22	exemption applies to holders of commercial driver's licenses as long as the person is in compliance with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations, which
23	currently prohibit engaging in texting while driving.
