COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 533, L.D. 703, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Governing Licensure Compliance Methods for Camping Areas, Recreational Camps, Youth Camps and Eating Establishments"

Amend the bill in section 2 in §2497 in the 2nd paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "in each year" and inserting the following: 'every 2 years'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment requires the inspection of a licensed establishment at least once every 2 years instead of at least once a year as proposed in the bill.
