SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 210,
L.D. 721, Bill, "An Act To Extend the Use of Underground Storage Tanks"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 5 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 5. Rulemaking. The Department of Environmental Protection shall amend its rules in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375 to allow the retrofitting of single-walled underground storage tanks with secondary containment systems prior to the expiration of the tank manufacturer's warranty and to allow the upgrading of related piping. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the rule-making provision in Committee Amendment "A" to require the Department of Environmental Protection to amend its rules to allow the retrofitting of single-walled underground storage tanks with secondary containment systems prior to the expiration of the tank manufacturer's warranty and to allow the upgrading of related piping.
