1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1101, sub-§4-A,** as enacted by PL 2005, c. 430, §1 and
3 affected by §10, is amended to read:

4 **4-A.** "Methamphetamine precursor drug" means any drug or product possessed by a
5 person that contains pseudoephedrine or in the aggregate a quantity of more than 9 grams
6 of ephedrine, ~~pseudoephedrine~~ or phenylpropanolamine or their salts, isomers or salts of
7 isomers, either alone or in combination with other ingredients, in dry or solid nonliquid
8 form.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill requires a prescription to possess any amount of pseudoephedrine.
