10 Persons To Perform Simple Electrical Repairs under Limited Licenses"

11 Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

12 '**Resolve, Directing the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation To**  
13 **Convene a Working Group To Review the Proposal for an Exception to the**  
14 **Electrician Licensing Requirements for Incidental Work'**

15 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and  
16 inserting the following:

17 '**Sec. 1. Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation to**  
18 **convene a working group to review the laws governing electricians to**  
19 **consider a limited exception for incidental work. Resolved:** That the  
20 Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation shall convene a working group  
21 with the Electricians' Examining Board, established under the Maine Revised Statutes,  
22 Title 5, section 12004-A, subsection 13, as well as other interested parties, to review the  
23 possible benefits and safety risks in creating a limited exception to the electrician  
24 licensing requirements under Title 32, chapter 17 for incidental work performed by  
25 persons whose occupations involve miscellaneous jobs of manual labor; and be it further

26 '**Sec. 2. Reporting date established. Resolved:** That, no later than January 15,  
27 2012, the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation shall submit a report of  
28 the findings and recommendations of the working group under section 1 to the Joint  
29 Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic Development. That  
30 committee is authorized to introduce a bill based on the report to the Second Regular  
31 Session of the 125th Legislature.'

32 SUMMARY

33 This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve and is a minority report of the  
34 committee. The amendment directs the Commissioner of Professional and Financial  
35 Regulation to convene a working group with the Electricians' Examining Board, as well

1 as other interested parties, to review the possible benefits and safety risks in creating a  
2 limited exception to the electrician licensing requirements for incidental work performed  
3 by persons whose occupations involve miscellaneous jobs of manual labor. The  
4 amendment requires the Commissioner of Professional and Financial Regulation to  
5 submit a report no later than January 15, 2012 following the review by the working group  
6 to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic  
7 Development. It authorizes the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce,  
8 Research and Economic Development to introduce a bill based on the report to the  
9 Second Regular Session of the 125th Legislature.
