1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §302**, as amended by PL 1997, c. 526, §14, is further amended
3 to read:

4 **§302. Unorganized territories**

5 The Bureau of Revenue Services ~~shall be~~ is responsible for the performance of the
6 assessing function in the unorganized territory of the State and this territory ~~shall~~
7 ~~constitute~~ constitutes a single primary assessing unit. If an assessment would increase the
8 assessed value of a parcel of land by more than 25% of its previously assessed value in
9 one year, the increased assessment must be phased in so that the assessed value of a
10 parcel of land increases by no more than 25% in a single year.

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill provides that an increase in the assessed value of a parcel of land in the
13 unorganized territory that exceeds 25% of its previously assessed value must be phased in
14 so that the assessed value of a parcel of land increases by no more than 25% in a single
15 year.
