3 4	92. Certain sales of precious metals. Every sale of gold, silver, platinum and palladium bars, bullion and coins that is \$1,000 or greater in value.

6 7	This bill exempts from sales tax every sale of gold, silver, platinum and palladium bars, bullion and coins that is \$1,000 or greater in value.
