2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §685-B, sub-§6-A, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 687, §2, is amended to read:
4 5 6	C. A copy of the certified plan must be filed within $\frac{30\ 90}{100}$ days of certification with the State Tax Assessor and the appropriate registry of deeds in the county in which the land is located.
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill extends the time by which certified plans for a subdivision must be filed from 30 days to 90 days.
