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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 645, L.D. 878, Bill, "An Act To Provide a Temporary License To Operate a Public Dance Establishment"

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Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 7 (page 1, lines 3 to 8 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

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'7. Temporary license. Following the transfer of ownership of a building used for public dances licensed under this section, a new owner that applies for a new dancing license for that building may simultaneously apply to the Commissioner of Public Safety for a temporary dancing license. The commissioner may issue a temporary dancing license, which is valid for a period of 60 days or until a decision is made on the application submitted pursuant to subsection 3, whichever is shorter. The fee for a temporary dancing license issued pursuant to this subsection is \$100.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment clarifies that a temporary license for a public dancing establishment would be issued only following the transfer of ownership of a building used for public dances that has an existing license.

Additional costs to the Department of Public Safety associated with processing and issuing temporary dancing licenses can be absorbed with existing staff and within existing budgeted resources. Other Special Revenue Funds revenue to the Department of Public Safety may increase by minor amounts not requiring any change to the budget from temporary dancing license fees.
