COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 654, L.D. 887, Bill, "An Act To Include Medicinal Marijuana Patients in the Controlled Substances Prescription Monitoring Program"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Include Medical Marijuana Patients in the Controlled Substances Prescription Monitoring Program'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §7249-A in the headnote (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "medicinal" and inserting the following: 'medical'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §7249-A in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "medicinal" and inserting the following: 'medical'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
