1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1065, sub-§4, as amended by PL 2003, c. 493, §12 and affected by §14, is further amended to read:
4 5	<b>4.</b> Minors not allowed on premises. Minors are not permitted to remain on the premises except when:
6 7	A. The minor is accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or custodian as defined in Title 22, section 4002; or
8 9	B. The licensee does not permit consumption of liquor on the premises for a specific period of time or event.
10	SUMMARY
11 12	This bill repeals the exceptions that allow minors to be on the premises of establishments licensed to sell alcohol as a Class A lounge and clarifies that minors are

13 not allowed on the premises.
