

SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 662,
L.D. 903, Bill, "An Act To Allow a Student Attending Private School Access to Public
School Cocurricular, Interscholastic and Extracurricular Activities"

Amend the amendment in the 2nd indented paragraph after the title in the 6th and 7th
lines (page 1, lines 19 and 20 in amendment) by striking out the following: "that enrolls
fewer than 30 students"

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the restriction that allows only private schools that enroll
fewer than 30 students to be eligible to participate in public school cocurricular,
extracurricular and interscholastic activities.
