For the purposes of this subsection, "medical emergency" means a condition that, on the basis of the physician's good faith clinical judgment, so complicates the medical condition of a</u>
16 17 18	pregnant woman as to necessitate the immediate abortion of her pregnancy to avert her death or to avoid a delay that would create serious risk of substantial and irreversible impairment of a major bodily function.'
19	SUMMARY
20	This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary.
21 22 23	This amendment adds a medical emergency exception to the requirement that a pregnant woman be provided with specific information at least 24 hours before an abortion procedure may proceed.
