COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 686, L.D. 926, Bill, "An Act To Increase the Credit Toward Payment of Fines Given for Jail Time"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (1) in the 4th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25" and inserting the following: "\$100"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (2) in the 4th line from the end (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "not less than \$5 \$25" and inserting the following: '~~not less than \$5~~ up to \$100'

SUMMARY

This amendment increases the rate of credit to up to \$100 per day of confinement. The bill increases the rate of credit from the current \$5 to \$25.
