1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2007** is enacted to read:

3 **§2007. Concealed firearms in State House**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person to whom a valid permit to carry
5 a concealed firearm has been issued as provided in this chapter may carry a concealed
6 firearm in the State House.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill provides that a person to whom a valid permit to carry a concealed firearm
9 has been issued may carry a concealed firearm in the State House.
