§	1094-U. Limited practice dental hygienist
<u>tc</u>	The Board of Dental Examiners shall issue a limited practice dental hygienist license an individual who meets licensure requirements established by the board.
b	1. Qualifications. The board by rule shall establish licensure requirements for a mited practice dental hygienist license that include educational requirements that may e met through any course of study approved by the American Dental Association ommission on Dental Accreditation or its successor organization that:
	A. Allows distance learning with instruction from qualified practitioners;
	B. Includes nontraditional clinical instruction and clinical training as a dental assistant with a licensed dentist; and
	C. Involves a number of credit hours equivalent to a 2-year full-time program.
	2. Scope of license. A limited practice dental hygienist license allows a person to rovide nontherapeutic, limited preventative care, as established by the board by rule.  3. Fees; license. An application for a limited practice dental hygienist license must accompanied by a fee to be determined by the board not to exceed \$175. The board hall issue a license to practice as a limited practice dental hygienist in this State to an adividual who has met the licensure requirements. The license must be exhibited ablicly at the person's place of employment. The license authorizes practice as a limited ractice dental hygienist in this State for the year in which it is issued until the expiration at that appears on the license. On or before January 1st of each odd-numbered year, the mited practice dental hygienist must pay to the board a license renewal fee of not more than \$175, to be determined by the board. A limited practice dental hygienist who has not add the renewal fee on or before January 1st must be reinstated upon payment of a late that appears on the license renewal is due. Failure to be properly licensed by February 1st of the car in which license renewal is due. 3 SUMMARY

This bill establishes a limited practice dental hygienist license that allows a person to provide nontherapeutic, limited preventative care. Qualifications for this license may be met through any course of study approved by the American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation or its successor organization that allows distance learning with instruction from qualified practitioners, includes nontraditional clinical instruction and clinical training as a dental assistant with a licensed dentist and involves a number of credit hours equivalent to a 2-year full-time program.
