COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 699, L.D. 939, Bill, "An Act To Enhance Mandated Reporting and Prosecution of Elder Abuse, Neglect and Exploitation"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraphs (26) and (27) (page 2, lines 19 and 20 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'(26) A naturopathic doctor;'

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph A by renumbering the subparagraphs to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment deletes from the proposed list of mandated reporters municipal code enforcement officials and firefighters. The amendment also adds naturopathic doctors to the list of mandated reporters.
