SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 708, L.D. 964, "Resolve, Requiring the Department of Education To Amend Its Rules To Prohibit School Administrative Units from Imposing Unreasonable Restrictions That Impede the Ability of Parents and Evaluators To Observe Students"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "determined necessary by the qualified examiner" and inserting the following: 'the school would permit a qualified examiner that is employed by the school'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment specifies that the rules adopted must permit a qualified independent examiner to observe the child at the times and for the duration that the school would permit an examiner employed by the school.
