SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 728, L.D. 984, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine To Require a Two-thirds Vote To Approve the Issuance of a Bond or Security by the Maine Governmental Facilities Authority"

Amend the bill in section 14 in the 18th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Houses" the following: 'except for bonds or securities authorized by the Legislature prior to January 1, 2011'

Amend the bill in the question in the last line (page 2, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Authority" the following: 'except for bonds or securities authorized by the Legislature prior to January 1, 2011'

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts from the 2/3 vote requirement bonds or securities authorized by the Legislature prior to January 1, 2011.
