4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to increase school administrative units' access to federal Medicaid
6 funding for medically necessary services provided by those school administrative units to
7 special education students for whom those services are required under an individualized
8 education plan adopted for the student and as part of a free and appropriate public
9 education.
