3 4	4. Standard of proof. The burden of proof that a traffic infraction has occurred is on the State and must be established by a standard of clear and convincing evidence.

6 7	This bill places the burden of proof of a traffic infraction on the State and establishes a standard of clear and convincing evidence for proof of a violation.
