Board of trustees. All the affairs of the water district are managed by a 16 board of trustees composed of 3 members, who are residents and voters in the district. 17 Whenever the term of office of a trustee expires by the trustee's removal from the water 18 district or otherwise, the legal voters of the water district shall elect a successor to serve 19 for a full term of 3 years; and if any other vacancy occurs, it may be filled in like manner 20 for the unexpired term. Nominations and elections of trustees are conducted in 21 accordance with the laws relating to municipal elections by secret ballot according to the 22 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 2528. The annual meeting occurs at a time 23 and place designated by the trustees. The annual meeting for the election of officers 24 occurs at a time and place designated by the trustees. As soon as is convenient after the 25 board of trustees has been elected, the trustees shall hold a meeting and organize by the 26 election of a chair and clerk, adopt a corporate seal and choose a treasurer and all other 27 needful officers and agents for the proper management of the affairs of the water district, 28 Each member is entitled to compensation as set by the trustees for the member's services 29 for each and every regular and special meeting of the board at which the member is in 30 attendance. The water district, at any legal meeting of the water district called for the 31 purpose, may adopt such bylaws and provisions, not inconsistent with the Constitution of 32 Maine and laws of this State and of the United States, as the water district may determine 33 expedient and necessary for the good government and regulation of the affairs of the 34 water district, in which case, the bylaws and provisions so adopted apply to the water 35 district as fully, to all intents and purposes, as the other provisions of this Act, subject to 36 alterations and additions, only by a 2/3 vote of all the legal voters of the water district 37 present and voting at a legal meeting of the water district called for the purpose.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 754, L.D. 1018

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Sec. 3. Current trustees. Trustees of the Anson Water District serving on the effective date of this Act continue to serve for the terms for which they were elected.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that nominations and elections of trustees of the Anson Water District are conducted in accordance with the laws relating to municipal elections by secret ballot according to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 2528. It also clarifies that trustees serving on the effective date of this bill continue to serve for the terms for which they were elected.
