HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 791,
L.D. 1056, Bill, "An Act To Increase the Availability of Independent Medical Examiners
under the Workers' Compensation Act of 1992"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 (page 1, lines 25 to 35 and
page 2, lines 1 to 19 in amendment)

Amend the amendment in section 3 in subsection 2 in the 4th line from the end (page
3, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "that examines an employee in
accordance with section 207" and inserting the following: 'selected and paid for by an
employer to examine an employee in accordance with section 207 is limited to 12 such
examinations per calendar year and'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter
or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that an independent medical examiner chosen by an
employer to conduct an examination of an employee is limited to performing 12 such
examinations in a calendar year.
