Resolved: That the Department of Conservation and 2 the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, referred to in this resolve as "the 3 departments," shall jointly develop recommendations to establish and fund a mitigation fund for damage caused to private land by unauthorized all-terrain vehicle use. The 4 5 departments shall develop guidelines for the operation of the mitigation fund, including 6 recommendations for an ongoing source of money for the mitigation fund. In developing 7 recommendations for a source of money, the departments shall consider, but are not 8 limited to, dedicating a portion of all-terrain vehicle registration fees; and be it further

9 Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the departments shall report their 10 recommendations and any necessary implementing legislation to the Joint Standing 11 Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by January 1, 2012. The joint standing 12 committee is authorized to report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of the 13 125th Legislature.

SUMMARY
This resolve requires the Department of Conservation and the Department of Inland
Fisheries and Wildlife to jointly develop recommendations to establish and fund a
mitigation fund for damage caused by unauthorized all-terrain vehicle use on private
land. The recommendations, along with any necessary implementing legislation, must be
submitted to the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by January 1,
2012.
